Comments: The operator must demonstrate a purposefully planned program by documenting their plans for daily activities.

Comments: The address of one emergency contact was missing in one of the children's records and a contact emergency number was missing in two of the children's records. This information must be indicated, as the emergency contacts must be able to reach the facility within one hour.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (c) staff member records that include (iv) a signed declaration confirming that the staff member has read and understood his or her obligations under the Act and this Regulation.	24(1)(c)(iv)	Jun 02, 2023	
Comments: Operator does not have the signed statement regarding obligations under the Act and licensing regulations. This must be added to their file.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (f) daily attendance records of the children on forms provided by the Minister.	24(1)(f)	May 26, 2023	
Comments: During the Renewal Inspection, the inspector observed that the absences codes are not used consistently on the daily attendance records to indicate the reason for the child's absence. Operator must ensure that absences codes are used to indicate the reason for the child's absence.			
25 An operator of a licensed facility shall post in a clearly visible and prominent place on the premises: (e) the name and telephone number of the inspector.	25(e)	Jun 02, 2023	
Comments: Name and telephone number of the inspector aren't posted. The information should be posted in a visible place.

Comments: Toxic products were found up on a shelf in the downstairs bathroom. All toxic products must be locked in a cabinet with a key.
