Comments: In 1 out 5 child record file verified the address of the medical practitioner is incomplete. In another file the medical practitioner information is missing. All child rescored files must include the name, address and the phone number of the medical practitioner. The operator must ensure that all child record files are complete.

Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children transitioning to the outdoor play area. The operator forgot to bring the attendance sheet with her. When children are in the outdoor play area or on outings, operators must have a copy of the attendance records with them as well as emergency contact information.

Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed a fire extinguisher that was expired. The operator is not aware that fire extinguishers are to be inspected yearly. The operator is responsible to ensure that inspections are completed.						
35 An operator of a licensed facility shall not permit a child receiving services at the licensed facility access to a trampoline.		35		23, 2024		
Comments: In the outdoor play area, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a mini trampoline.Trampolines and mini trampolines are not to be used on-site nor during outings.There is a serious risk of injury to children using trampolines and restricting their use helps to keep children safe from injuries. The trampoline must be removed or made inaccessible to children.
