Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed two lunch boxes that were not labeled with the name of the child. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that all personal belongings must be clearly labeled with the child's name. The operator labeled the lunch boxes with the names of the children. Deficiency is now compliant.							
General Comments							

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct the renewal inspection. The ratio was respected during the inspection.

The QAM observed that the art material was too high for the children to reach. The QAM observed the children could ask the operator for art material. The operator informed the QAM that she had a cart to put the art material lower, but she used the cart to put shoes in. The operator informed the QAM that she will put another stand at the children's height.

The QAM was able to observe that the operator has completed 7 h of professional learning in the current renewal year. The operator has until the end of June to complete her 10 h of professional learning hours in reason of the renewal period ends at the end of June. The operator informs the QAM that she is registered for professional development session in the coming days. The operator will send a picture to the QAM of her certificate or appendix B once completed.

General Comments

The QAM observed the children playing in the indoor play area. The children worked on their cutting skills with scissors, played with stickers and slime. The children were observed transitioning to lunch time and then nap time. The QAM did not observe the children waking up from their nap and eating their snack. This will be observed during the next monitoring inspection. The operator informs the QAM that the children don't sleep more than 2h.
