During the Monitoring Inspection, Inspector overheard the Educators in the 3/4 year old room asking the children to clean up the toys. It was overheard that only two children would be given stickers as "super cleaners".

Discussed with Educators in the room that positive child guidance includes setting reasonable limits and guidelines that make sense to the children; offering choices and assisting children in decision-making, understanding child development; using positive reinforcement and encouragement rather than competition, comparison and criticism.

## **General Comments**

A monitoring inspection occurred today to confirm the following: Ratio, staff checks, and staff qualifications and training.

The orders for compliance on this report were from a visit to the childcare centre earlier this week. Inspector verified that child-to-staff ratio was being met and maintained throughout the day. All staff on site had all required Criminal Record Checks/ Vulnerable Sector Checks, Social Development Checks, First Aid training, job descriptions, signed statements, Early Childhood Education Certificate and/or 90hr Introduction to Early Childhood Education. (trained or waiting training to begin).
