General Comments
<p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the morning on February 26, 2026</p> <p>Upon arrival, all children were observed in the outdoor play area, engaged in a variety of activities that included digging with shovels, going down the slide, and jumping in the snow. They then transitioned indoors</p> <p>Two-Three-year-Old Room: the children were observed transitioning to indoors and engaging in a magnetic sand invitation that was set upon for them and playing with dinosaurs alongside their educator. Additionally, one child was observed eating snack with handwashing occurring beforehand.</p> <p>Four-Year-Old Room- The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities, including drawing at the table, using bingo dabbers, creating with cardboard boxes, exploring a water bin with water animals, and looking at books. Additionally, several children were observed eating snack.</p> <p>School Age Room: The school age children were not in attendance at the time of the inspection. The room was observed to be set up with invitations and ready for the children's arrival.</p>

General Comments

Several forms of documentation were visible throughout the facility, including learning stories, photographs, and children's artwork.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, and monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills.

A conversation with the administrator occurred on the following:

- Creating an outdoor container to provide children with easily accessible materials while outdoors. Examples of materials to add, but not limited to, include markers, paint, crayons, notepads, pencils, chalk, animal figures, clipboards, and paper.
- Creating a visual schedule in the four-year-old classroom and ensuring it is posted in a visible place for the children to view.
- Recommending that outdoor toys be stored in a designated storage bin.
- Creating "work in progress" signs for children to place on projects they wish to continue later, ensuring these items are not put away during clean up.
