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<p>General Comments</p> <p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the morning and afternoon.</p> <p>Two Three-year-old room: The children were observed napping and in the outdoor environment.</p> <p>Three Four- Year-Old Room: the children were observed engaged in a variety of activities that included using playdough with cookie cutters, a farm-themed play setup with animals, trees and tractors, and singing with actions led by the educator. A "Can You Build a Bug" table was also available, featuring bug figures, books, and related bug facts.</p> <p>Outdoor Play: Both groups were observed outdoors engaged in a variety of activities, including going down the slide, digging in the sandbox, using the play kitchen with water play, playing with balls, and building with large connecting blocks.</p> <p>The rooms are well-organized and inviting, offering a varied supply of age-appropriate materials, books, and toys. Traffic areas are kept clean, and outdoor walkways are free of clutter. Toxic products such as cleaning agents are securely locked and inaccessible to children.</p> <p>Positive child guidance techniques were observed. The educators were observed to be engaging at the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, using encouraging language, offering choices, and assisting children with decision-making.</p> <p>A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.</p> <p>A conversation took place with the Acting Administrator regarding the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Educators monitor the UV index and ensure that sunscreen is applied and reapplied as needed during outdoor
