General Comments
A Monitoring Inspection was conducted this morning. The infants were getting ready for a walk at QAM's arrival. A Tuff Tray was observed, and educators stated that the infants would be exploring it after their walk. The Tuff Tray contained wood, dry pasta, large pom poms, feathers, spoons, and plates. Infants bathroom / change area was observed. All diaper changing procedures were being followed. The 2/3 group were taking part in free play at QAM's arrival. Children were observed building forts with blankets, climbing on their indoor climbing gym, eating snacks, and listening to their educator read a book. The room contained several learning / play centers - a cozy reading area, gross motor area, arts & crafts, and building. Children's interests were evident and were displayed on the wall, via a word web - dinosaurs, transportation, animals, dolls, and books. Several forms of documentation were observed, including children's photos, artwork, and learning stories. Positive child guidance techniques were observed - educator offering choices, educator allowing children to explore during a read aloud, and educator providing appropriate supervision. The preschool room was observed. The room contained several well-defined learning / play areas – dramatic play, cozy reading area, building, science, and arts and crafts. No preschool children were present during today's inspection. The after-school room was also observed. It was evident that the school-aged children are presently interested in arts and crafts, especially those involving the usage of cardboard. Several forms of documentation were observed – children's art, photos, and learning stories. The school aged children were not present during today's inspection.
