Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that in one out of 6 child records verified the emergency contacts address provided was in Ontario. This is the second reminder that the emergency contact must be able to come pick up the child within one hour after being contacted , meaning the emergency contacts provided must live no further then one hour away from the facility.
