Attended the centre to perform a monitoring inspection.</p> <p>Materials and activity areas in centre were observed to be well maintained and contained developmentally appropriate materials. Invitations to play were offered with loose parts and materials set out with a note stating, "can you build a leprechaun trap?"</p> <p>Parent board can be updated with Quality Assurance Monitor changed to Jenelle Hanscom email: jenelle.hanscom@gnb.ca phone: 506-429-2102</p> <p>Educators advised that they play a children's trivia game with the after schoolers each day as they line up after school and they find this engages the children and helps to pass the time and lessen behaviours as they wait for all the children.</p> <p>Observed children in the outdoor play space, which is the Centreville School playground. After schoolers were combined with separate afterschool program which is a part of the Centreville School. Educators from both programs were spread out appropriately to provide supervision of the large space. Extra supervision was provided to children engaging in risky play on the large snow pile, with one educator supervising from the top and one from the bottom. Positive behaviour guidance and positive interactions were observed at all time throughout the monitoring inspection.</p>
