General Comments

On the day of the visit the facility was celebrating Earth Day through a variety of activities that were planned for the week from craft activities and nature walks.

As I walked into the Two-year-old room there an unfinished painting activity on the table. As I talked to one of the educators, she stated that she noticed the children were not interested in the activity and switched to another activity that the children were more interested in. This is a good example of the educators following the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework is based on child lead learning. The educator followed the interest and needs of the children.

The classrooms are clean and organized. The child size furniture, large windows, natural and wooden materials give the rooms a "home-like" feeling. The children are represented in the rooms through family photos, candid photos of the children participating in various activities and learning stories that are posted throughout the facility.

During outdoor play the children were observed making a "banana cake" in the mud kitchen, going through an obstacle course of tires and balancing boards, digging in the dirt, playing on the slide, rolling tires, sitting at the tables drawing pictures and reading books in the quiet area of the outdoor space.

The educators were actively engaged with the children by reading stories, drawing pictures, digging in the dirt and chasing the children around the playground. During lunch time the educators were sitting at the table eating lunch with the children.

The facility seemed to be running smoothly on the day of the visit.
