Comments: Deficiency is now compliant. As discussed with the Educator, she would need to create an outdoor checklist to reflect the toys, equipment and materials located in this space and track monthly maintenance. The Operator showed up during my visit and this was completed during my visit.			

<b>General Comments</b>
<p>Monitoring visit performed.</p> <p>Upon arrival children were eating snack. Educators followed children's lead and allowed them to take their time eating. Those that finished early have a routine, to wash hands and move over to the mat and play quietly. The eating time was relaxed which made for an enjoyable experience.</p> <p>Afterwards, educators and children dressed appropriately for outdoor play. The space includes a good size sand box, book corner, dump trucks, art/chalk board easel, mud kitchen with implements, balance beams, and includes a playhouse. The educators also brought out balls and other loose parts. Lots of choices were provided including a fun art activity. I suggested making the outdoor book house more accessible so children could reach in to get a book. It is my understanding the tables children used indoors for eating snack will also be lowered.</p> <p>Lots of wonderful recent programming posted - camp cook out and walks to the park. Children really enjoy these adventures and also headed out after having some play time inside their outdoor fenced in playspace.</p> <p>Administrative reports were reviewed during my visit - attendance is tracked, fire drills performed monthly and with the school and incident reports are being documented and signed by parents the day of, so parents are aware.</p> <p>Appropriate child guidance was observed. Educators were engaged and interacting with children. Educators spoke to children at their eye level and they were observed offering choices (do you want to wash your hands at this sink or the big sink), gentle reminders (we will be going outdoors soon) and reflecting with children on incidents (throwing rocks could hurt you)</p> <p>All children were enjoying their morning. The indoor play area is inviting, and toys, equipment and materials are accessible, and children's learning is visible with programming posted.</p>
