Comments: During licensing staff visit there is no evidence of daily program posted in the school age classroom. Licensing staff asked to review the programming for the last month, but the Educator was unable to provide that information.

Comments: Fire drills were not practiced and documented in the school age classroom in February. Please ensure these drills are practiced monthly and recorded. Please advise when the fire drill has been performed in March.

Comments: As per the outdoor maintenance report, a couple of deficiencies were noted but have not been fixed. Please advise when this has been repaired.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring inspection visit performed. Jenelle Hanscom (new licensing staff) also accompanied me during the visit.</p> <p>Upon arrival, most preschool age children were napping. Other children were observed lying quietly on their mats looking at books or playing with k'nects. It is recommended that children resting on mats, but remaining awake, must not be required to stay on the mat for longer than 30 minutes.</p> <p>Licensing staff proceeded to the school age program room. Children were eating their lunches and then moved onto free play activities. There does not seem to be many activities planned today with exception of outdoor play</p>

General Comments

in the school age room. Children would benefit from structured activities and/ or long-term projects to extend learning and recognize children's interests. Children have interests currently in monsters, fort building, obstacle course. Perhaps books could be introduced and other resources to extend the children's interests in these topics. Afterschool program educators could refer to Appendix 24 in the operator manual and section 7 as this will provide ideas for resources.
