Comments: Deficiency is now compliant. During the visit, it was discovered that the ISW worker's job description did not accurately describe the educator's responsibilities. This was corrected during the inspection visit.			

<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Upon arrival a small group of school age children had finished eating lunch and were involved in quiet activities. The afterschool program room is inviting, and materials are assessable, and incorporates children's likes, passions and interests. The educator had several programming stations set up and many children were playing at these play stations - a table sand play area, and rice play area, a water play table, and play doh station. Children were also observed playing with dolls. All children were playing cooperatively with their friends. The educator used appropriate child guidance techniques and supervision was appropriate. The educator is aware of children's safety at all times and was observed intervening and redirecting negative behavior when required. The educator speaks to children in a kind and respectful manner when she interacts. She also kneels down to speak to children and asks them gently to use their words. For transitioning the educator uses a 1,2,3 number system and children are familiar with this routine and they will stop to listen. The educator uses a group 'gem' jar to encourage children to be respectful with their friends and when walking in the hallway and using good manners. This is March break so children are attending for the entire day. The educator has a variety of activities planned for the remainder of the week. Today is superhero and princess day. Many children came dressed in costume today.</p> <p>There were 2 educators on site during the inspection, so they were covering off each other's lunch. Administrative records were reviewed, and attendance of educators and children are being tracked daily, including fire drill records are practiced monthly. No incident or illnesses to report.</p> <p>Educator files were also reviewed during the inspection visit. Please refer to the comment above.</p> <p>Children were observed eating snack and soon after everyone cleaned up the play area and they prepared to get dressed for outside play. Licensing staff joined children as they lined up to walk outside together. It was a warm spring like day and the timing was perfect as the educator recognized that children needed to be outside and burn off some extra energy.</p>
