<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities outdoors this afternoon. Children were observed exploring playground equipment, building forts in the woods, blowing bubbles and drawing with sidewalk chalk.</p> <p>An inspection of the indoor play area - classroom environment was conducted; however, the children were not observed indoors due to the warm weather. The indoor play area is set up with a variety of materials and invitations for the children to explore. The gym environment was not set-up today due to the low number of children in attendance and the extra outdoor time.</p> <p>The surfacing under the swings needs to be raked to redistribute the mulch in the fall zone. QA Monitor discussed with staff during inspection.</p> <p>The children were served a picnic snack of crackers with cream cheese and peaches. Monthly fire drills are documented.</p>

General Comments

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.
New staff file (3) review was completed. One staff file was missing a First Aid/CPR certificate - QA Monitor was able to confirm digitally. Ensure certificate is added to file.
Incident logs were observed to be filled out when required, however; a few were not signed by parent/guardians. Ensure incident logs are signed.
