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General Comments

Upon arrival the children were playing outside. The children have access to basket ball, 4 Square, bean bag toss, dirt to dig in, planter with plants, a kitchen, a small house, hockey nets and balls. As the space is quite large and the children play in the centre of the space, more shade should cover the area.

The children cleaned up and entered the facility where they divided into two groups. The younger school age children ate snack while the older school age children played in the gym with the educators. The educators were observed as directly engaged with the children at all times and became part of the play.

The administrator advised licensing staff that they do have set times for meals and snacks however they do base eating on individual needs. Therefore, if a child was hungry, they would not stop them from eating something from their lunch containers

As the children were finishing up eating, it was observed that educators had set up invitations to play for the children. Today they encouraged building competitions with materials to build however some of the children moved into other areas. Other materials within the facility include cars, ramps, magnetics, blocks, lego, a kitchen set, card and board games, puzzles, books, and lincoln logs to name a few.

The transitions were observed as smooth and calm. The children know what is expected of them and are guided positively with encouragement and praise.

The planning for the children is purposeful and evident. Licensing staff observed pictures of a caterpillar that the children had made with their hands. It is recommended that more of the children's pictures, photos and documentation be placed on the walls.

Files were easily verified by licensing staff. They were complete and organized.

Licensing can now recommend facility for licensing pending a new fire inspection.
