General Comments

I was accompanied by Jenelle Hanscom for the monitoring inspection. This is the operator's first monitoring visit since becoming licensed.

Children were playing with playdough upon our arrival. The main play space has a large, low table to allow for both the infants and preschoolers to reach the materials set out. A variety of materials were accessible for the children- doctor kit for pretend play, blocks, animals and a doll house. A quiet, cozy reading area is around the corner with pillows and books.

When transitioning to outside, children were provided with time to practice getting dressed independently and she was nearby to offer help.

The operator used positive child guidance when children needed reminders or were upset. She encouraged children to use their words to share their feelings with their friends. The operator read books and sang songs to comfort infants when sad. Some children had some big feelings when coming back inside and the operator used patience and compassion when navigating this.

The kitchen/dining area has books about birds set on the two windows. The table had recent art pieces the children had created with crayons and paint. The different colors and types of paint allowed for an open art experience.

Child files were checked. The operator keeps them in her locked filing cabinet. All required information and documentation were included. Daily information sheets for infants are being completed and there were past Potential Illness Forms and Return After Exclusion Forms. These are being done correctly and included signatures from parents.

General Comments

In regards to the bathroom ceiling, the Qualilty Assurance Monitor will be in touch with further direction after consultation with Public Health.
