Quality Assurance monitor observed child ask for more snack. Child was given extra peanut butter, cheese, and pretzel crisps.

Children were very engaged in a science experiment involving guessing what is inside balloons.

Quality Assurance monitor observed one child that decided they were done completing the science activity and moved into freeplay. Several children continued squishing the balloons after the experiments was completed.

QAM observed educator helping children to work out an issue between them in a kind way.

Discussion with inclusion support worker on tools and resources for the children she is working with.

Children playing freeze dance, the floor is lava and various group games.

Toy cupboard is open, children had access to all toys during inspection. 3 tables were set up with various activities including crafting, board games, and a water sensory table.
