The four-year-old group was just getting back from a field trip to the Christmas tree lost where they picked out a tree for their classroom. While at the tree lot, the children drank hot chocolate around the campfire, and the educator read a story "Pick a Pine Tree" by Patricia Toht.

Once the group got settle into the room, they had some free play time. Some of the children played in the kitchen making cookies and pancakes with playdough, while others were drawing pictures are the table. This room has started a Confidence Building Program by having the children try new foods and documenting their comments about the food. So far, they have tried pumpkin seeds, snap peas, beets and pomegranate seeds. The infant group were having free playtime while dedicators were doing diaper change and preparing for lunch. The children were observed playing on the slide, sitting at the table, and looking at books. Before lunch time the educator read a story "Farm".

The three-year-old group were eating lunch. Early in the day they were making crafts and paintings that were on the shelves drying.

The twos were finishing up lunch and the educator read a story "The Old lady who swallowed a Moose" before nap time.

The classrooms are nicely organized with many natural items and soft lighting.

The facility is following the NB Curriculum framework based on the learning stories and artwork posted throughout the rooms, webbing in each classroom of the children's interests and a weekly planning scheduled posted in each room.
