General Comments
<p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility to conduct the annual License Renewal Inspection while children were still arriving for the day.</p> <p>Indoor play environments were calm and inviting, with soft lighting and quiet music. Each classroom included sensory tuff trays tailored to the age group. In the infant room, the tray contained shredded paper, small vehicles, a kitchen strainer, and a muffin tin. The three-year-old classroom featured a tray with assorted beans and legumes, plastic dinosaurs, applesauce pouch caps, bowls, cleaned fruit cup containers, and small tree cookies.</p> <p>In the two-year-old classroom, educators had prepared an animal themed safari centre with books, small plastic animals, palm trees, and a base of artificial grass. The preschool classroom offered a tea party play centre.</p> <p>Outdoors, licensing staff observed a natural learning environment that included a wooden tent structure built by children and educators using fallen tree branches. A fire pit was also present, and children reported having enjoyed a bonfire the previous day where they roasted marshmallows.</p> <p>School aged children arrived later in the day, briefly entering the facility to use the washroom and wash their hands before going outdoors for snack and play. Children were seen eating at a picnic table and inside a large truck tire, while some chose to climb a nearby tree with peers.</p> <p>All educators were engaged with the children and used positive child guidance strategies with the children when needed.</p> <p>All files were well organized and contained the required licensing information.</p> <p>Licensing staff recommends the facility for license renewal.</p>
