Comments: Lack of current documentation posted and invitations for learning not present to demonstrate purposeful planning. Documentation of children's learning, creativity, ideas, and projects is to be updated and posted regularly to make children's learning visible, provide opportunities for them to revisit their work, and invite parents and others to view what children are learning and interested in. Invitations and provocations set up daily inspire new learning and invite children to build on current interests, curiosities, and passions. Discussed with preschool educators at time of inspection.

Comments: One staff member without valid FA and CPR certificate. Operator reports that staff are scheduled to complete the course soon. As discussed, staff member cannot be left alone with children until a valid FA/CPR certificate is obtained.

Comments: Fence board at corner of house in poor repair with protruding screws. To be replaced.

General Comments
<p>A renewal inspection was completed today. Children and educators were observed in the indoor and outdoor play environments, during transitions, at lunch and nap time. Educators were observed to engage in play and conversation with children throughout the inspection.</p> <p>Indoor play environments have a variety of materials that are accessible to the children. Books, games, small manipulatives, blocks, creative art, and dramatic play interest centres were present. Ensure clutter is removed from tops of shelving to create a more inviting and welcoming space.</p> <p>Outdoors, a variety of loose parts, cars and trucks, gross motor activities and creative art materials were present.</p> <p>As discussed with preschool educators, incident logs of children are not to be viewable by others. Recommendation to cut notebook in half so that there is only one incident recorded per page.</p> <p>A random review of children's and staff files was completed. Files were complete with all required documentation present.</p>
