General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on July 25, 2025.

Children were observed during indoor and outdoor free play as well as during snack time. Proper handwashing routines were followed, and steps or platforms were available to help children access regular-sized sinks and toilets independently.

Educators stated that the children are currently very interested in learning sign language, using cutting and gluing materials for art activities, visiting the community market and local parks for field trips, and being active outdoors. Educators were observed using positive language and providing gentle reminders to support children's development. Outdoors, educators played an active role in engaging with the children during activities.

A daily incident log is maintained. Outdoor play occurs for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time when the majority of children are in attendance, weather permitting. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed and posted. The daily routine is visibly posted in each room, and evacuation procedures are displayed in a prominent location. Ideas from web resources and learning stories are reflected in various areas of the environment, including the art area, library, kitchen, and dramatic play zones. The facility has a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys to support children's learning and play.

The changing area is located within one metre of a sink, and diaper changing procedures are posted and clearly visible to staff. Allergy information for children is posted. The infant outdoor play area is either separate from or used at different times than other age groups to ensure safe and developmentally appropriate outdoor experiences. Children's portfolios are being completed, and children have access to them. Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility, reflecting the children's learning and experiences.
