Comments: Licneisng observed that the "Consent to Administer Medication-On-going Treatment was not filled out for one child in the preschool room. Discussed with on-site Administrator/Educator. This form is to be given to the parent/guardian to fill out the required information. Recommending that a copy is kept with the medication and a copy kept in the child's file.			

General Comments
A renewal inspection was conducted for both the half-day preschool program and the afternoon school-age program. Upon arrival at the childcare facility, licensing observed the preschool-aged children preparing for their morning snack alongside their educator. The educator was observed sitting with the children during snack time, actively engaging them in meaningful conversation. Transitions throughout the morning program were observed to occur naturally and seamlessly. Licensing discussed with the on-site Administrator/Educator that the facility's current licence includes a preschool program and an after-school program. The preschool licence encompasses children aged 2 to 5 years who have not yet entered school. Further discussion occurred regarding the potential enrollment of children under three years of age who are not yet toilet trained. Licensing advised that a diaper-changing mat would need to be purchased for the washroom and stored appropriately when not in use. In addition, a diaper-changing procedure would need to be posted in the washroom, and dedicated storage would need to be provided for children's diapers, wipes, creams, and other related supplies. During the preschool program, licensing observed children participating in a science experiment involving water, test tubes, and eyedroppers. Children were also observed playing musical instruments and singing with their educator, engaging in open-ended art activities using glue, paper, crayons, scissors, paint sticks, and stampers, constructing with blocks and connectors, and participating in a "Find the Monkey" game where children hid and

searched for a toy monkey throughout the learning environment.

During the school-age program, licensing observed children arriving by bus and participating in afternoon snack with their peers and educators. Children were also observed drawing, engaging in dramatic play within the kitchen area, building with LEGO, and playing with dolls, dollhouses, and related accessories.

Licensing observed educators in both the preschool and school-age programs consistently using positive child-guidance techniques during their interactions with the children in their care. Educators were observed sitting with children, engaging in conversations, and providing active supervision throughout the various learning environments within the facility.

Overall, the programs were observed to provide a welcoming, engaging, and developmentally appropriate environment that supported children's learning, exploration, and social interactions.
