<p>General Comments</p> <p>A renewal inspection was conducted today for the after-school program. Children were actively engaged in a variety of activities throughout the classroom, and multiple learning environments were thoughtfully set up.</p> <p>Children were observed using new hacky sacks to practice juggling, while another child created an obstacle course using foam blocks. A selection of costumes donated by the church, originally used for theatre productions and resembling mid-century attire, was available for dramatic play. Two Bristol boards were displayed beside the costumes, illustrating examples of clothing styles from 1760–1977 and how they evolved over time.</p> <p>A game centre was set up with several board and group games, including Battleship, Tumble Tower, Frustration, Twister, and Scrabble. An educator had recently asked administration for ideas to support a child who enjoys measuring materials in the kitchen area; the plan is to introduce noodles as an additional sensory and measuring material.</p> <p>A cozy corner was arranged with a couch, pillows, teddy bears, a rug, and a variety of books. Clear bins containing loose parts, including different types of magnetic blocks, were available on the shelves. Children were also engaged in play with Barbies and related accessories. A craft corner was stocked with paper, glueables, popsicle sticks, markers, pencil crayons, and other creative materials.</p> <p>Staff files and board member files were reviewed and complete. Eight children's files were also verified and complete. Children bring their own lunches and snacks from home.</p> <p>It is noted that the fire inspection on file is not current. Administration believes the fire inspector has visited since the previous inspection dated 2024-05-15 and will contact them to obtain an updated copy to forward to licensing.</p>
