General Comments					
A Monitoring inspection occurred October 14, 2025					
The children were observed engaging in a variety of outdoor activities, including swinging on the swings, playing hopscotch, participating in a volleyball game with their educator, digging tunnels in the sandbox, peeling potatoes in the mud kitchen, potatoes that were grown in the facility's garden, exploring the wooded area, drawing while sitting in the hammock, playing tetherball, and climbing on the large spools. The indoor environment was thoughtfully set up and inviting for the children upon arrival. Documentation observed included learning stories, learning webs, cabbage stamping, corn art pieces, and an "All About Me" wall. The educators indicated that the children are currently showing interest in the newly added shrimp in the fish tank, exploring animal facts, and using the newly introduced electric microscope. The microscope allows children to take photos of natural materials they collect. Educators demonstrated positive interactions by using encouraging language and gentle reminders. They asked					
open-ended questions, listened actively, and extended children's ideas through conversations.					
A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility's license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.
