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General Comments

A renewal inspection was conducted for the preschool program.

The preschool children were observed participating in a variety of engaging activities both indoors and outdoors. Indoors, children were observed during snack time, lunch, and nap time. They participated in art activities using glue, googly eyes, paper plates, heart shapes, and markers. Children were also observed playing in the dramatic play area and building forts. During lunch, the children enjoyed a pizza and popsicle party. Educators were observed sitting with the children, engaging in meaningful conversations, and supporting positive interactions throughout the day.

Outdoors, the children were observed participating in water play, riding bicycles and plasma cars, building with blocks, playing with toy animals, swinging, digging, and engaging in play with their educators. The educators were appropriately positioned throughout the outdoor play space, ensuring effective supervision while maintaining positive and responsive interactions with the children.

The classrooms were arranged with a wide range of open-ended materials to support children's learning and play experiences. Invitations to play were thoughtfully prepared and available for the children upon their return from outdoor play. Materials were stored on low, open shelves, making them easily accessible and promoting independent choice and exploration. Documentation was current and reflective of the children's recent learning experiences. Photographs of the children and samples of their artwork were displayed throughout both the indoor and outdoor environments.

The following records were reviewed during the inspection: incident logs, fire drill records, daily attendance records, professional learning records, a sample of children's files, and all staff files. Handwashing and diaper-changing practices were also observed.

Five staff members require additional professional learning hours and are expected to complete their remaining hours by September 30, 2026. The Quality Assurance Monitor will follow up on this item during the next monitoring inspection.

General Comments

The inspector discussed with the on-site administrator the use of small choking hazards, including small pom-poms, buttons, and shells, in Room 9 while children as young as two years of age are in attendance.

The facility is recommended for licensing.
