Comments: At the time of the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the last emergency evacuation and fire drill was completed in March. Monthly emergency and fire drills are to be completed. The Quality Assurance Monitor insists that an emergency and fire drill be completed within the next week.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (c) stored separately for each child.	40(1)(c)	Jun 07, 2024	
Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed book bags, jackets, clothes, lunch box, shoes etc. on the floor and all mixed up. The facility has a labelled and easily accessible space for personal belongings; however, most of the children's personal belonging were on the floor. With that, personal belonging was not stored separately for each child. Using the space provided for personal belongings helps keep items separate so that belongings do not get lost or mixed up. It also helps reduce the risk of communicable disease. The operator must ensure that children's personal belongings be stored separately for each child.
