## **General Comments**

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the children were having morning snack. As the children finished eating, they went to the bathroom before getting ready to go outside. The Operator was observed helping the children get ready which made for a smooth transition to the outdoor play space.

The outdoor play space is well maintained and offers a variety of materials for the children to use. A small group of children made a pretend fire, collecting branches and pine needles in a pile. The children were observed laughing and talking as they sat together around their fire. While playing outside the fire alarm in the facility went off as part of their monthly fire drill. All children carefully walked to their meeting space and sat patiently as the Educators did roll call. Once all children were accounted for, the children walked back to the playground to continue playing.

The Infant and 2's room transitioned inside first to get ready for lunch. Proper diaper changing procedures were observed and all children washed their hands before sitting at the tables for lunch. Once they were settled, the 3-year-old class and 4-year-old class came inside to prepare for lunch. This made for a smooth transition inside for all groups. The Operator was observed helping children get their winter gear off, heating up lunches and setting up cots for nap time.

The classrooms are clean and organized. Pre-planning is evident throughout the facility. There were several framed pictures and learning stories displayed on shelves at the children's level. Only positive child guidance was observed. Educators were heard offering praise, words of encouragement and high 5's. During today's visit staff files and child profiles were reviewed. Files were easily accessed and contained all required documents. A broken crazy carpet was found outside on the playground. Please ensure any broken materials are thrown away.
