General Comments						
Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the License Renewal Inspection while children were still being dropped off for the day.						
Child-to-staff ratios were maintained according to the Early Childhood Services Act throughout the inspection.						
In each classroom, the educators were observed interacting with the children at the child's level while they were in the indoor and outdoor play environments throughout the license renewal inspection.						
The indoor learning environments are inviting and welcoming and have evidence of the children's learning posted on the walls for the children to revisit learning experiences.						
While observing in the 3/4-year-old classroom, the educators observed the children engaging in a variety of invitations of play that were set up by the educators. One invitation of play consisted of a building activity using "pipeline building blocks." Another invitation of play consisted of a memory game using small, wooden, circular tiles with different types of fruit painted on them. The third invitation of play was comprised of markers and plain white paper. When the children satiated with the white paper, the educator added small square pieces of paper with frogs, frog eggs, and tadpoles for the children to colour and draw on.						
While outside playing in the outdoor play environment, one of the children showed the educator a moth on the ground that was fluttering its wings. The educator gently picked up the moth and placed it on their arm and the moth moved up the educator's arm. The children were very interested in watching the moth.						
All staff and children's files were complete with all of the required documentation.						
Licensing staff is recommending this license for renewal.
