Monitoring Inspection - PreK Program Only: Children and educators were observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including sensory opportunities, watercolor painting, Lego, dramatic play and fine motor activities. Educators observed at children's level engaging in meaningful conversations and encouraging children to problem solve independently. QA Monitor discussed adding more materials that support the children's current interests and displaying books throughout the interest centres. Bananas, Trail Mix and milk were served for snack this morning. Handwashing routines were observed during washroom routines and after painting. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. New staff file (3) review was completed, all required documents are in place.
