General Comments							
After outside play and lunches, children were offered a leaf craft in one preschool room while the other room had invitations set up with one educator engaged in building with children and the second educator reading with a child. One child that naps was set up on a cot in an area of the room to not be disturbed and visible to educators.							
Documentation was evident in both rooms with a prompt asking children what they should learn about with their responses. A discussion between licensing staff and educators focused on ensuring creative activities provided to children are open-ended and writing materials are accessible for children to print their names. The educator has each child's name laminated in a basket for the children to use for support. The educator commented she shows the children each of their names during circle time and they can recognize their own and their friend's names. Learning stories posted showed evidence of learning related to science, the earth, bugs, and planting.							
A sensory table was located within each room with a variety of leaves, small logs, pinecones, and magnifying glasses. Educators were reminded that invitations should include texts such as picture books, informational texts, and resources. Educators mentioned they have purchased texts to support invitations as they are not always available. Licensing staff discovered while searching texts in each room that only 3 texts related to fall were available, so the educators shared them. Educators, administrators, and the operator were encouraged to make a list of texts to support children's interests, abilities, passions, and to support created invitations and provocations. The library can be an additional resource to ensure educators have the texts they need to support children's learning. For favorite authors and illustrators, a collection of texts could support children's interests which could extend to include digital technologies to learn more about the author/illustrator and their artistic style.
