Comments: While observing children in one of the classroom, licensing staff notice the baseboard in the classroom is coming off the walls. Please fix this as it poses to be a safety hazard for the children.

Comments: While observing the children in the outdoor play environment, licensing staff noticed that there is not varied and sufficient quantity of play materials for all children. Please add additional play materials for the children to play with while engaging in outdoor play.			

General Comments
<p>Licensing staff attended the licensed facility to conduct the annual license renewal inspection.</p> <p>Upon arrival at the facility, the children were observed eating their morning snack. Following snack time, the children gathered at the cozy centre to participate in a circle time activity. Educators and children engaged in singing activities, including "Baby Shark" and "Shake Your Sillies Out," followed by practicing the song the children will be performing at their graduation ceremony.</p> <p>After the songs, the educator called out each child's name, allowing them to choose a coloured felt square to sit on during circle time. As the children were seated, educators sang the "Good Morning Train" song to welcome everyone to the circle.</p> <p>During the activity, each child was given an opportunity to identify and point to the letter that their name begins with, as well as the letter of the day, which was the letter "F." Educators and children then reviewed the life cycle of a butterfly together.</p> <p>Following circle time, the children transitioned to tables to participate in a painting activity. Children were provided with white paper and painted it green. Once the activity was completed, educators displayed the artwork to dry. Educators indicated that, once dry, the children will cut circular segments from the painted pages</p>

General Comments

to create a caterpillar craft.

After the painting activity, the children moved to their cubbies to put on outdoor clothing in preparation for outdoor play.

While outdoors, children were observed engaging in active play, including playing with a soccer ball, digging in the sandbox, running, and jumping. Educators encouraged risky play by allowing children to climb onto a small wooden picnic table and jump off under staff supervision.

Licensing staff reviewed all educator files and a sample of children's files. All reviewed files contained the required documentation in accordance with the Early Childhood Services Act.

Child-to-staff ratios were observed to be within regulatory requirements as outlined in the Early Childhood Services Act.
