General Comments
When licensing staff arrived, the last group of children were due to arrive. Children already present were engaged in play in one side of the room due to reduced numbers. Children were independent in choosing what to play with as all resources were accessible. A large art center is located in one corner of the space with a bookshelf with different art materials, scissors, glue, and paint as well as a table with additional writing materials and paper. Children were requesting some images to be printed so they could color them. A lego table was present in each room and children were building. The drawer in the lego table has separated so a repair is needed. Games, large and small were available, a basketball net set up in the front window area, and large houses for play. A collaborative poster of the children's handprints was posted recognizing Every Child Matters. Posters of summer activities were posted above the children's pegs and a watch us grow poster posted on the door with children's heights. Educators mentioned they are beginning to create more documentation related to Halloween.

General Comments

There were bookshelves located in each room and book racks with a variety of texts including chapter books, search and find, informational, narratives, picture books, and a selection of magazines. Each book area had a rug and some soft seating available.

There have been some updates to the outdoor play space with a large area for sandbox play. Wooden tracks are positioned in front of the sandboxes and mud kitchen. Resources have been cleaned up and resources available. Educators gave reminders of transitions and clean ups. A verbal prompt by educators was recognized and responded to by children.
