When I arrived, Candy and the children were playing outside. New outdoor play material was added such as a ninja course for risky play, a mud kitchen area and some balance beams. The structure is being maintained and was recently renovated with a new roof, wood and paint.

The indoor play area is clean and organized. The children have access to many quality materials. All aspects of the NB Curriculum are present and were observed. Many opportunities for learning and literacy. Candy has creative ideas to teach the children and it's evident that she allocates a lot of time to her environment to ensure the children have different learning opportunities.

The children know the routine and are thought independence. The children seem happy in their Learning and Childcare Home, lots of laughter was heard during my inspection. The children are often seen playing with Candy, laughing with her or asking to hold her hand while they walk outside in the playground.

Candy was heard speaking to the children in a respectful and kind manner.

The children did circle time, they learned about colours, letters, and days of the week. They sang together, the children were being silly and laughing. Learning is being presented to the children in a fun way and so the children are excited and are engaged in their learning.

All files and documentation is organized and completed as per the requirements of the Act and Regulations. Programing is pre-planned and documented.

There is documented evidence of the children's learning such as learning stories and the children's art and projects on the walls.

I would recommend removing the metal frame in the outdoor play area as it's no properly secure and not being used for play.

Everything is in compliance, I recommend for renewal.
