General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the Early Learning and Childcare Home to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the children were in the process of waking up from nap time. The children used the washroom while the Operator put away napping materials.

Several positive changes have been made to the indoor environment. The walls have been painted a light grey and navy color, and new flooring was put down over the holidays. A large wooden shelf was removed from the craft area which opened up more play space for the children. The entry way was tidy, organized and inviting. Each child has their own hook and space for their personal belongings with their picture displayed above. Learning stories, pictures of the children and information for families was posted on the walls before entering the classroom. Allergies were posted and the Parent Board contained all required information.

Throughout the afternoon the children were engaged in a variety of activities. The Operator sat at the table with the children as they made pizzas and smoothies with slime and playdoh. A bin of Play Doh accessories was available for the children to use. They were observed using various accessories to roll, flattening, cutting and stretching the slime and playdoh. Later in the afternoon the children decided they wanted to add stamps into their play. Gentle reminders were heard before the children cleaned up and washed hands for afternoon snack.

As the children ate afternoon snack, the Operator laid out snowpants, jackets, hats and mittens to prepare for outdoor play. The transition from inside to outside was smooth. The Operator is patient with the children and encourages their independence. Praise and words of encouragement were heard throughout today's Monitoring Inspection. Only positive child guidance was observed.
