All toxic products are kept in a locked cupboard under the sink.							
<ul> <li>A reminder that attendance records are:</li> <li>mandatory</li> <li>recorded using the attendance form provided by the department (Appendix 10)</li> <li>completed each time a child arrives and leaves</li> <li>accurate and reflect all children present at any given time</li> <li>taken out of the facility whenever children leave the building</li> <li>When children are in the outdoor play area or on outings, staff members have copies of the attendance records with them as well as emergency contact information.</li> </ul>							
It is recommended that all toy bins and shelves be labelled. Having appropriately labelled bins and shelves allow for independent selection and help for room organization. It is recommended that labels have both words and pictures to promote literacy skills.							
Children should wear proper indoor footwear at all times in case of an emergency evacuation.							
Please ensure that all area rugs, slipcovers, and couches are vacuumed/clean as per Public Health guidelines.							
It is recommended that children ask or inform educator to leave the room before leaving for safety purposes.							
Please ensure top of shelves are kept tidy to avoid clutter and possible breakage of play material should they not be properly put away.
