### General Comments

Upon Licensing staff arrival, the Operator was preparing for morning snack and the children were playing with an ice cream stand in the main play space.

During snack, the preschool age children sat together at the small table in the kitchen space and the infant sat close by in a highchair. The Operator was observed singing with the children and offering them additional snacks from their lunch bags when asked for more. After snack, the table was cleaned, the chairs were put aside, and the Operator asked the children if they would like to go outdoors to play. The children were excited and helped tidy up their toys.

The main play space was organized and clean. Children's artwork and photos were on display and personal belongings were neatly hung up on hooks with names. Play material such as a large playhouse, a wooden play kitchen, dolls, a chalk board easel and labelled bins of animals, musical items, dinosaurs, wooden blocks, magnet tiles and loose play pieces were all in good condition and easily accessible.

Before going outdoors, diapers were changed, sunscreen was applied, and water bottles were gathered to be brought outdoors. The outdoor space had plenty of natural shade from a large tree in the middle of the yard and outdoor play material such a play kitchen, sandbox, water tables, cozy coupe cars, slides and balls were in good condition. The Operator was observed playing soccer, pushing cozy coupes and looking for insects with the children. Positive child guidance was observed after a small disagreement between friends. The Operator spoke softly to the children and demonstrated patience and understanding.

During inspection, daily attendance records and child files were verified. Monthly fire drills are being conducted as well as recorded and the parent board was visible with required documentation posted.

Licensing staff recommends for renewal.
