Comments: While reviewing Staff Files it was observed that an associated person was missing a copy of their criminal record check. A conversation was had with the Operator to ensure a copy is added to the file. The Operator will send an email once this has been added.			

General Comments
Licensing Staff arrived at Miles of Smiles to conduct a Renewal Inspection. Upon entering the home several positive changes were observed. New flooring and lights have been added since the last visit. The indoor environment was bright and welcoming upon arrival. The children were in the process of having morning snack. The older children finished eating first and were observed stacking blocks and spinning on a new sensory spinning chair. Proper diaper changing procedures were observed after morning snack time. Sunscreen and bug spray was applied before the group transitioned outside. Water bottles and bubbles were also brought outside. It is evident the Operator takes good care of the outdoor play materials. All materials were in good condition. While playing outside the children were seen using the slides, a musical wall, water tables and riding in little tikes push cars. The Operator follows the interests and needs of the children. A conversation was had with the group asking if they would like to go inside for lunch or stay outside for a bit longer to play. Together they decided they would stay outside for 10 more minutes. The transition back inside was smooth. The children washed their hands and had free play before having lunch. The Operator set out coloring pages, stickers and bingo dabbers for the children as lunches were being warmed up. As the children finished eating, those who nap transitioned to nap time while the other children played quietly in the main room, building a train track. Throughout the inspection, only positive child guidance practices were observed. The Operator sat with the children, clapping, building towers and engaged in conversation. Child files were reviewed and found to be in compliance. A conversation was had with the Operator about organizing documents such as daily information sheets, weekly planning sheets, attendance records etc.
