A Monitoring Inspection occurred on June 21, 2024.						
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During the inspection, children were observed engaging in both outdoor and indoor free play, transitioning from nap time to free time, and moving from free play to snack time. Proper handwashing was consistently observed during these transitions, and steps or platforms were provided to help children reach regular-sized toilets or sinks. Educators reported that the children were particularly interested in a bird's nest with eggs found outside. They documented the eggs by taking pictures and brought elements of the outside environment into the classroom. Positive language and gentle reminders were used by educators, who also included their interests in their documentation. Outdoors, educators played an active role in children's activities. The facility ensured outdoor play for at least one hour in each four-hour block, weather permitting. Snacks were provided at least every three hours, with meals at recognized periods. Parents and children were enthusiastically greeted upon arrival, and books reflecting children's interests were selected. The facility had a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys. Well-defined learning and play areas were observed, and children's artwork was displayed throughout the facility. Menus were provided to parents for the food service, and drinking water was available throughout the day. Regarding the curriculum, several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility. Educators extended curriculum opportunities outdoors and made efforts to incorporate the natural world into the classroom environment.
