General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection took place on September 4, 2024.

Children were observed engaging in indoor quiet rest and infant mealtime.

Educator shared that the children have recently shown interest in a new dramatic play centre, specifically a farmer's market fruit stand, and in creating a new family wall for children in the home. Throughout the inspection, educator was observed using positive language and offering gentle reminders. Positive child guidance techniques were consistently demonstrated, including getting down to the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, offering choices, and assisting children when needed.

The home ensures that parents of children present have unrestricted access to the facility at any time. A dedicated space is available to display the license, current inspection report, monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. The daily routine and weekly menu, including substitutions, are posted for parents' reference. Parents and children are greeted with enthusiasm upon arrival, and the room is thoughtfully arranged to be inviting, with materials set up to encourage play. Books selected reflect the children's interests, and well-defined learning and play areas were observed, along with several displays of children's artwork throughout the facility. Traffic areas, both indoor and outdoor, are kept clean and free of clutter, and toxic products are securely stored out of children's reach. The diaper-changing area is located less than a meter from a sink, and diaper-changing procedures are clearly posted. The outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of an appropriate depth.

Daily activities are purposefully planned and documented within the program, providing opportunities for both individual and group experiences. Various forms of literacy are integrated into the indoor environment, supporting the children's development.
