General Comments

Renewal Inspection:

The children were observed inside exploring the dramatic play area which was turned into a camping site. The Operator shared with the Inspector that the children had been showing interest in camping after recently going camping with their families. The camp site included, a tent, grass, picnic basket with food, and a campfire.

Documentation and pictures of the children reflected the children's on-going learning interests. The Operator displayed the children's learning throughout the indoor environment. Each learning story highlights the children's play experience and reflects the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework. The Operator shared with the Inspector that they are currently in the process of making individual binders for each child to keep all documentation in.

The outside environment had a variety of materials for the kids to play with, such as balls, dolls, sand, mud kitchen, art materials, mark-making materials, water toys, and bikes. The children were observed playing with cars, riding bikes, climbing the climbing structure, swinging on swings, and playing with super soakers, and water. The children showed excitement as they showed the Inspector their garden. They are currently growing peas, carrots, pumpkins, broccoli, lettuce, and cucumbers.

The Operator was observed playing with the children and accommodating each child and their interests as they explored the outside play area.

The children shared they were excited to have a pizza party to celebrate one of their friends last day.

The following records were reviewed: Incident reports, fire drills, daily attendance sheets, infant toddler daily sheets, administration of medication, and staff professional learning hours.

Operator's file was viewed, and all of the child files were reviewed.

Facility is recommended for licensing.
