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<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>A monitoring inspection took place today in the morning.</p> <p>The children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor environments, including during transitions between the two. Additionally, the children were observed eating their snack. With handwashing occurring beforehand.</p> <p>Indoors, the children were observed engaging in a variety of activities that included using magnetic blocks, walking on the steppingstones, using play dough, and playing with monster trucks. Outdoors, the children were observed climbing on the climbing dome, using the ride on toys, sliding down the slide, and using buckets, scoops, pots, and utensils alongside the operator.</p> <p>The operator indicated that the children are currently interested in sensory activities specifically slime, trucks, building and outdoors.</p> <p>Several forms of documentation were visible throughout the room, including photographs, children's artwork, learning stories and individual portfolios. The room was well organized and inviting, offering a variety of appropriate materials, books, and toys.</p> <p>The operator demonstrated positive interactions by using encouraging language and gentle reminders, asking open-ended questions, listening actively, and extending children's ideas through conversations.</p> <p>The home maintains a clearly visible and prominent space for posting the license, current inspection report, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, daily information sheets, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.</p>
