**General Comments**

Licensing Staff arrived at the Facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, both staff members were outside the facility as they waited for the children to arrive from school. One child had already been dropped off on site and was playing catch with the staff members as they waited. Once the final bus arrived, the children were greeted as they exited the bus. The Educator was observed reaching out to families of children who did not get off the bus to confirm their absence.

As the group entered the facility the children hung up their personal items and washed their hands. Some children chose to have snack while others engaged in activities. The Educator stated the group is really interested in crafts and painting right now. A large table was set up with a variety of paint, paint brushes and paper. A smaller group of children chose to continue creating with Lego. Once the children had finished their paintings and those who wanted snack had finished eating, the group prepared for outside. Bookbags were packed and brought outside for end of day pick up.

A bag of Mega Blocks was brought outside for those who were interested in building. A large group gathered together and decided on an active game they wanted to play. Throughout the afternoon children were observed building cars, dinosaurs and towers with the Mega blocks as well as playing active games and playing skip rope. The staff members were well spread out to ensure all areas outside were supervised. A conversation was had on site as a reminder with the warmer weather to please throw out and replace any damaged play materials.

Only positive child guidance was observed on site today. Both staff members were attentive to the needs of the children and followed their interest. The staff members playing different games with the group and sat building creations out of Lego as well. Staff and child files were reviewed today. All files were organized and contained all required documents. Fire drills and an outdoor maintenance checklist was also observed and up to date.
