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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children observed engaged in a variety of activities this afternoon including art, a STEM activity, and building with foam mats. An invitation was set-up that challenged the children to build a boat with a variety of materials to see if it will float. Children were observed testing if their boats float in a bin of water.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environments to support the children's current interests (STEM, art and nature).</p> <p>Dramatic play materials are becoming depleted. Examples of items to add, but not limited to costumes, hats, scarves, purses, office supplies, restaurant items, clipboards, cash register, money, pretend food, real life items, loose parts, tools, items that support the children's interests.</p> <p>Playdough was observed to be dried up. To be removed and replenished.</p> <p>Clutter, sand and debris are accumulating on the window ledges, the rug and in the corners of the room. To be cleaned regularly. Recommend utilizing the window ledges to display materials in a way that invites children to engage or create.</p> <p>Oranges and crackers were served for snack. Children and staff did not wash their hands at arrival or before snack. Ensure hand washing routines are reviewed and implemented. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance records - QA Monitor discussed signing children in/out on attendance when changing groups. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. New staff file (2) review was completed; all required documents are in place. Incident logs are complete and signed by parent/guardians.</p>
