General Comments
Monitoring Inspection - Summer Day Camp: A Monitoring Inspection was conducted this morning to follow up on orders for compliance ahead of upcoming Renewal Inspection. It was determined that previously issued orders remain outstanding. The indoor play area was observed to be disorganized and cluttered, with an accumulation of sand, garbage, and food debris present throughout the area. Ensure all outstanding orders are addressed. A cleaning and organization schedule for the indoor play area is to be implemented to ensure it remains free from clutter, sand, garbage, and food debris. QA Monitor reviewed the recommendations provided during the previous Monitoring Inspection with staff as it was determined that the recommendations had not yet been implemented. Recommendations were left with staff on ways to make the environment more inviting for the children. Examples of items to add, but not limited to plants, soft lighting, photos, documentation supporting current

interests and experiences, challenges, art pieces, items from nature and age-appropriate books displayed throughout the room. QA Monitor discussed utilizing the window ledges and tops of shelving to display materials, books and children's creations.

During the previous inspection it was determined that children have an interest in building, spiders, venomous animals, and gross motor games. Purposeful planning continues not to reflect the ongoing interests of the children. QA Monitor discussed with educator during inspection today.

A hot glue station, pencils and pencil crayons have been added to art area however, pencil sharpeners, and erasers are not accessible to the children, to be added.

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.
