Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding the protective surfacing in the outdoor play area. The current protective surfacing under the stationary equipment is compact and not of appropriate depth. An application for change to change the protective surfacing under the stationary equipment was sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor. In the meantime, to ensure safety, the children are prohibited to use the stationary equipment. In order to comply with this requirement until the change is complete, the protective surfacing can also be turned over or raked (to reach the appropriate depth).			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection. At the time of the visit, the followings were verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If all required documents are posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility - Daily activities include: - Diaper changing - Outdoor play area materials and equipment <p>During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor remeasured one classroom. The allocation of space form will be updated and sent to the operator as soon as possible. The outdoor play area was also measured during the visit.</p> <p>At the time of the inspection, the infants went out for a walk, enjoying the nice weather. All other groups went into the outdoor play area for free play.</p>

General Comments

The ratio was respected at the time of the visit.

The facility implements an inclusive daily program which contains a variety of purposely planned activities, opportunities and experiences. The Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe documentary evidence of the child's learning throughout the facility via learning stories.
