Comments: Inspector observed a non-reportable incident report from August 6, 2025, that was not signed by the parent. Parents are to be notified on the day of the incident to their child.			

General Comments
<p>A renewal re-inspection occurred on August 8, 2025, as the facility was closed on July 22, 2025, when the Inspector arrived to conduct the renewal inspection on the license.</p> <p>Upon arrival, Inspector observed the school-age children playing basketball outside and socializing with their peers.</p> <p>Inside, Inspector observed morning snack, children engaged in board games, coloring, building in the construction zone, and dramatic play.</p> <p>After lunch the children left for the park and scheduled swimming lessons.</p> <p>Discussed with the Operator, Administrator and Educators during the inspection that Inclusion Support Workers are not counted in ratio, but the child/children they support are. When going to the pool, the Inclusion Support Worker is not counted in the reduced ratio of 1 educator to 8 school-age children if the child/children they support are in attendance. If the child/children are not in attendance, then the Inclusion Support Worker can be counted in ratio.</p> <p>Discussed the posting of allergies and what is required for the parent board unless there is written permission from the parent/guardian to post the child/children's name.</p> <p>Discussed with Administrator what is required to be posted on the parent board as per the Early Childhood Services Act and Regulations under the Act.</p> <p>All staff and operator files were reviewed and verified complete.</p> <p>A random review of 15 children's files occurred and were verified complete.</p>
