General Comments
<p>A Monitoring Inspection occurred in the morning of January 16, 2026</p> <p>Upon arrival, children were observed engaging in electronic time and free play activities, which included building with Lego and creating art at the table. The educator indicated that on PD days, children are permitted thirty minutes of electronic time.</p> <p>Upon returning to the facility from the playground, the children were observed preparing for lunch, with handwashing occurring beforehand.</p> <p>The educator indicated that the children are currently interested in Lego, art, and outdoor activities. Several forms of documentation were visible throughout the facility, including child print, photographs, and children's artwork. The rooms were well organized and inviting, offering a varied supply of age-appropriate materials, books, and toys.</p> <p>Educators demonstrated positive interactions by using encouraging language and gentle reminders. They asked open-ended questions, listened actively, and extended children's ideas through conversations.</p> <p>A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility's license, current monitoring reports, menu, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.</p>

General Comments

A conversation took place with the administrator regarding the following:

- Ensuring emergency evacuation procedures are posted by all exits.
- Licensing observed that the shelving has a buildup of dust and dirt. Shelving to be cleaned, and educators are to ensure proper ongoing cleaning.
