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General Comments

A renewal inspection was conducted over the course of the morning and afternoon.

Upon arrival at the school-age program, licensing staff observed the children preparing for lunch and subsequently eating their meals. Educators were observed assisting children with heating and opening their lunches as needed.

Following lunch, the children and educators participated in a nature walk along the Waterfowl Trail. Prior to the walk, children were engaged in a variety of activities, including building with LEGO, dramatic play in the kitchen area, playing with dolls, and reading books.

Educators reported that throughout the summer, children have participated in a wide range of activities and experiences, including swimming lessons, public swimming, tie-dye projects, golfing, trail walks, attendance at a community Children's Day fair, creating musical instruments and dream catchers, and outings to neighbourhood parks.

Licensing staff discussed the reduced staff-to-child ratio requirements for swimming activities with both the educator and administrator. Through this discussion, it was confirmed that the required reduced ratio was being maintained during swimming outings. Permission forms for both public swimming and swimming lessons were reviewed and verified.

Throughout the renewal inspection, educators were observed responding to the needs of the children and using positive child guidance practices when redirecting behaviours.

All staff and operator files were reviewed and found to contain the required documentation. In addition, a random review of ten (10) children's files was conducted, and all files were verified as complete and compliant with documentation requirements.

Based on the observations made and documentation reviewed during the inspection, the facility is recommended for licence renewal.
