I suggested revisiting the curriculum areas and putting out resources for the number of children so they are able to choose independently. Snack time was provided afterwards and then diaper changes. The children were taken for a walk to the park today and some play time. The operator followed the children's lead and noticed when they were growing tired. When arriving back at the home, children had their lunch.

The operator and I had a discussion about the documentation of children's learning and how the curriculum documents can support this. The operator would value support from the curriculum team.
