Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that the initial inspection report was not posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility. The Quality Assurance Monitor had found the inspection report in the operator's files, the Quality Assurance Monitor posted it right away in a visible and prominent place in the facility. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: In one out of 5 child records verified, the address for the emergency contact was missing. In one out of 5 child records verified, there was only one emergency contact listed. The name, address, and telephone number of at least 2 emergency contacts must be provided in the child records.

Comments: In 2 out of 5 child records verified, there was no child's health history including a copy of the immunization record or a copy of the exemption.

Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a child sitting down to eat a snack and the operator washed the child's hand with a washcloth. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observe children using the toilet or potty and not washing their hands after. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed the operator changing a diaper of an infant and the operator did not wash the hands of the infant after changing the diaper. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that handwashing is most effective with running water. The operator can refer to Section 11 in the operators Manuel and Appendix 36 and 37 to ensure that the facility complies with lighting, ventilation and other general health standards under the public health Act.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	May 03, 2024	
Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the children's water bottles were not labelled with the child's name. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that all children belongings must be labelled with the child's name.			
46(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall only administer medication to a child receiving services at the licensed facility in the following cases: (c) if the medication is not prescribed, the medication is (i) in the original container with the original label, (ii) in a container with child protective caps (iii) labelled with the child's name and the dosage.	46(1)(c)	May 03, 2024	
Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a bottle of children Advil that was not labelled with the child's name. The operator must ensure that non-prescribed medications must be in the original child safe container with the original label and labelled with the child's names and dosage.			
47(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall refuse admission to a child if satisfactory proof of the immunizations required by the Public Health Act or the regulations under that Act is not provided.	47(1)	Apr 29, 2024	
Comments: In 2 out of 5 child records verified, there was no child's health history including a copy of the immunization record or a copy of the exemption.
